



Mellanox Ships Over Ten Thousand InfiniBand Ports

Mellanox exceeds 2001 goals in shipments of InfiniBand Switch and Channel Adapter Ports for Clustering, Communications and Storage Applications

SANTA CLARA, CA and YOKNEAM, ISRAEL — November 14, 2001 — Mellanox Technologies, Ltd., the leading provider of InfiniBandSM silicon, announced today that the company has shipped more than ten thousand InfiniBand ports, which exceeds its target for 2001. This milestone comes less than 10 months after Mellanox's first customer shipments. The port shipment figure includes both InfiniBridgeTM and InfiniScaleTM channel adapters and switches supporting both 1X (2.5Gb/s) and 4X (10Gb/s) links. Shipments to more than 60 customers establish both InfiniBridge and InfiniScale as the leading InfiniBand silicon product families.

"InfiniBand technology is delivering true 10Gb/s transport capabilities today, offering greater performance and reliability for storage, communications and computing applications in the data center at a fraction of the cost of other 10Gb/s technologies," said Dave Sheffler, Mellanox Technologies, Vice President of Worldwide Sales. "IDC projects the number of InfiniBand ports for server applications alone to grow from nearly 330 thousand ports in 2002 to more than 6.8 million ports in 2005. Mellanox is pleased that this adoption cycle is on track and that its InfiniBridge and InfiniScale silicon are taking leading roles in this process."

Mellanox is the leading supplier of InfiniBand semiconductors, providing Switches, Host Channel Adapters, and Target Channel Adapters to the server, communications, and data storage markets. In January 2001, Mellanox Technologies delivered the InfiniBridge MT21108, the first 1X/4X InfiniBand device to market, and is now shipping second generation InfiniScale silicon. The company has raised more than \$33 million to date and has strong corporate and venture backing from Intel Capital, Raza Venture Management, Sequoia Capital, and US Venture Partners. In May 2001, Mellanox was selected by the Red Herring Magazine as one of the 50 most important private companies in the world. Mellanox currently has more than 200 employees in multiple sites worldwide.
